Selected from the best purple strip garlic found in Russia and Eastern Europe, this is a good addition to run alongside the popular Heritage Garlics. Large cloves, easy peeling vigorous hardnecks, they grow particularly well in our relatively soft UK climate, north or south, but can withstand temperatures down to -20C. Above ground it has a distinctive, dark green, vigorous wide leaf pattern and underground, the bulb is enclosed in tight leaf wrappers avoiding the pitfall of many hardneck types in our damp climate, of splitting and opening out. Planting in the autumn up until January, produces tight firm bulbs ready to harvest at the end of June. They can be dried after harvest in the open sun, verandah or glasshouse, their outer leaves slipping away to reveal the most beautiful marbled purple stripe bulbs. It is a classic "silverskin" <i>Allium Sativum</i> type, best late winter and spring planted and with the best keeping quality of any garlic we know – Up till June of the year following harvest. That is 10 months. From the same collection of garlic that includes Solent Wight, Picardy Wight and Tuscany Wight, it has outstanding vigour and is larger and bolder than similar types. This is an outstanding variety of garlic for the UK gardener. Plant the cloves 20-40mm deep, 12 to 15 cm apart, in rows 30 to 45cm apart root down, pointed end up into free draining soil. Mersley Wight will respond to 3 handfuls of Sulphate of Potash per meter length of row worked into the ground in the month after it emerges. Keep it watered from April through to approximately July 20 th. Harvest should follow as soon as the plants bend over, go "weak at the knees", in the following three weeks, no later. Dig carefully under the plants with a fork or spade, lift the garlic and hang or place in trays in a warm, dry place – a conservatory, glass house, polytunnel or open covered area with free air movement.
